For this term's New **CRAVE** Curriculum topic - **GEOGRAPHY**: We will be seeking to answer the question- **Where is Paddington Bear?** Throughout the term we will be focussing our attention to understanding maps, geographical features and the weather. We will enjoy walks around the local neighbourhood, around the school and the school woodland and will be receiving correspondence from Paddington Bear!

TOPIC HOMEWORK: Please complete at least one of the ideas below to support learning in school. You may however, choose your own if your child has a particular interest or idea. Please bring any work completed into school for us to share and display. Posting your photos and videos on Tapestry is important as we share these in class. Should you need extra resources such as paint or paper, please do not hesitate to ask- we are always more than happy to help.



GET OUTDOORS! Take a family neighbourhood walk. Talk with your child about familiar features such as the weather, park, local shop, trees etc.



Take a visit to the library and borrow a non-fiction atlas. Support your child to understand the world beyond the UK. Talk about different countries!



Play a game at home. Pretend you have forgotten how to find the kitchen etc. Ask your child to direct you using appropriate language.



Get creative! Ask your child to hide treasure and make a map. Can they name some geographical features (land marks) and mark them on the map?



Maths at home! Ask your child to find a selection of different objects and then sort them into numbered groups. Can they recognise numerals 1 to 5?



Phonics at home! Body percussion is using parts of the body to make sounds. Sing nursery rhymes and clap a beat; who can make the silliest sound?
