**History Target Vocabulary:** Artefact, family, time, rules, house, photograph, body, emotions, village, changes

**GET OUTDOORS!** Go to a local woodland or local park. Ask your child to collect natural objects and create a face of someone special. Frame it!



**GET READING!** Add an exciting dimension to reading. Read a book outdoors at a location relevant to the plot or characters.



**GET FINGERS MOVING.** Give your child a 1 metre length of string. Be creative- it has a multitude of uses: Cats cradle, fishing rod, measuring tape.....



**GET CREATIVE!** Gather natural materials to build a bird's nest. It should be- camouflaged; strong and sturdy; soft inside. What type of bird is it for?



**GET SORTING!** Egg box sort. Ask your child to collect and sort objects by their similarities. Colour, shape, material, size...Let your child decide!



**GET PHONICS!** Listen to sounds around you. Go to different places- noisy, quiet, calm. Can your child describe what they can hear?
