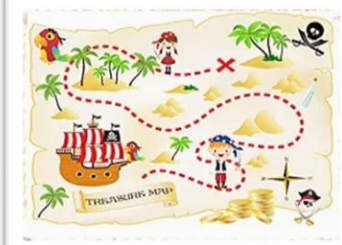
This term's New **CRAVE Curriculum** topic is **Geography** We will be seeking to answer the question – What can a map tell me?

These are mostly practical activities so- **PHOTOS ON TAPESTRY PLEASE!**



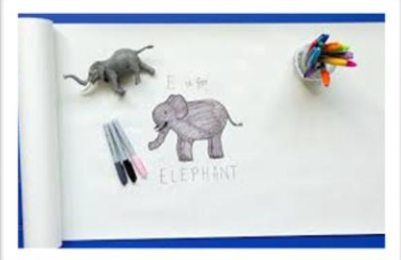
GET OUTDOORS! Go for a walk. Talk about different features- attach objects to a journey stick. At home talk about the objects in sequence.



GET ADVENTUROUS! Create a Pirate Map for your child to find hidden treasure. Read the map using directional language. Ask them to make a map.



GET FINGERS MOVING. Using play dough, ask your child to make wild animals from a habitat they can name. Can they name more habitats?



GET CREATIVE! Ask your child to draw, paint, collage or model their favourite African wild animal. Does it have paws, claws or whiskers?



GET WRITING! Practise recognising and writing numerals. Count out small objects and write a number to say how many there are.



GET PHONICS! Read nursery rhymes and rhyming texts daily. Sing the rhyming strings then talk about the words that rhyme, make up your own.
