GET OUTDOORS! Give your child a checklist of things to find. Something: green, beautiful, straight, fluffy, round, yellow, smooth and rough.




GET READING! Read a traditional tale for several occasions. Can your child repeat the phrases like 'Little pig, little pig let me come in'?
