GET OUTDOORS! Take your child to an area of natural beauty. Take some art supplies and have a go at life-drawing nature.



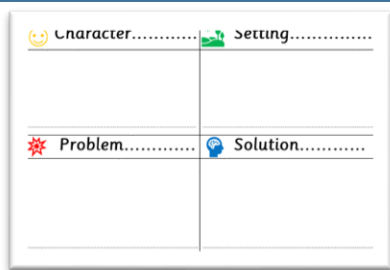
GET READING! Using a Non-Fiction text- Support your child to investigate the life of a minibeast and create a FACT FILE. Please bring to school.



GET HEALTHY EATING! Chat with your child about healthy food choices and encourage them to use a knife and fork independently. Photos !



GET CREATIVE! Using found natural materials create a collage of a minibeast. This can be done at home or out and about. Anywhere!



GET WRITING! Using the Story Grid ask your child to create a story. Scribe as they tell it. Reception should write it independently. All can Illustrate it!



GET PHONICS! Play Sound Hunt! Ask your child to bring you objects that start with a particular sound, such as 'b' boots, box, ball etc. Photos!
