GET OUTDOORS! Go for a woodland walk and ask your child to collect an object for our class nature basket- we will talk about their find in class.



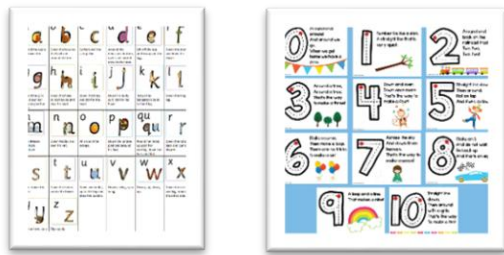
GET READING! Read your child's favourite story and ask them to retell their favourite part using sentences and their choice of media.



GET SORTING! Support your child to recycle your waste at home. Help them to name and identify the different materials. Photos Please!



GET RECYCLING! Use discarded objects to junk model your child's fascinations. It could be a car, camera, telescope, rocket. The choice is theirs!



GET WRITING! Practise recognising and writing numerals. Practise writing letters using the Read-Write-Ink rhymes and sheets sent home.



GET PHONICS! Spotting rhymes is the name of the game! Start with omitting words in nursery rhymes, can your child spot and say them?
