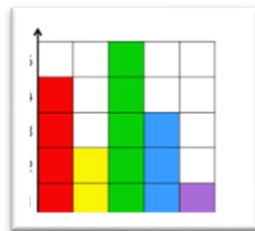

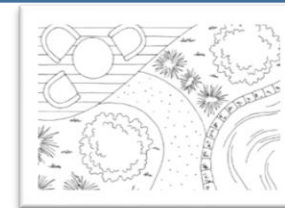
This term's New **CRAVE** Curriculum topic is **Geography (Our School Grounds)**!

**TOPIC HOMEWORK:** Please complete at least one of the challenges below to support learning in school. You may, however, choose your own if your child has a particular interest or idea. Please bring any work completed into school for us to share and display. Should you need extra resources such as paper, charts, or split pins do not hesitate to ask. Please also practice our topic vocabulary.

**Target Vocabulary:** aerial view, cardinal points, collection methods, compass, data, direction, facilities, fieldwork, human features, investigation, journey, maps, map key, observations, physical features, pictogram, plant life, position, record, route, sketch map, symbols, tally chart.



**WATCH THE WEATHER!** Create a weather diary and observe weather trends this Summer. You can do this in the form of short diary entries, a tally chart or block diagram (available in school). Challenge: is the sun affecting your sunflower's growth?



**TIME TO DRAW!** Draw a birds-eye view picture of your garden, bedroom or classroom. Have a go at drawing what it really looks like, and then have another go using basic symbols (e.g., circles for trees, lines for paths) and a key.



Take 1 step North.  
Now take 3 steps East.

**WHICH WAY?** Research which direction is North, East, South and West and make a compass. The compass could be made from paper, sticks or by chalking on the pavement. Can you direct a friend or parent to some buried treasure?



**BECOMING AN AUTHOR!** Write a short story about one time you explored outdoors – it might be a recount of somewhere you've been before or totally made up! Don't forget to include what you can see, smell, hear and feel.
