History Target Vocabulary: sharing, family, time, rules, house, senses, difference, emotions, favourite, growing

GET OUTDOORS! Take a family woodland walk. Ask your child to listen to the sounds, talk about what they can hear then draw it.



Take a visit to the library and borrow a book. How many family members can your child read it with?



Use paint to make handprints of your child's family members. Create a masterpiece and bring to school to display in the EYFS foyer.



Ask your child to draw a picture of their family. Talk about features such hair and eye colour- can they identify their own features?



Encourage your child to try new foods. Perhaps wary of broccoli, mushrooms or cheese- they may be pleasantly surprised!



Using building blocks or Duplo - ask your child to construct a representation of their home. Discuss the different rooms.
